Our puppies usually leave for their new home between 10 and 12 weeks of age, depending on their litter size and development. All of our puppies are born in our homes, usually in the living room next to the couch, since they tend to be born during the night. They are all raised within our home, socialized with people, children and other pets. We require a non-refundable \$500 deposit at 2 weeks of age to hold your puppy which is applied to the final price of \$1500.00. Our Lhasa Apsos represent generations of our breeding program and an intimate knowledge of those dogs, including their health and temperament. Our experience is applied to each and every breeding to produce, indeed, champions of competition and family pets of great character.
